The European Schools have their own curriculum which is the same in all the language sections.

# Job offer:

From **1 September 2019** the European School Bergen is looking for the following teachers in the **lower secondary** in the **ENGLISH section**:

- 1. Mathematics 4-8 periods per week (Job reference nr. 2019-06)
- 2. Integrated Sciences 8-12 periods per week a Physics, Biology or Chemistry teacher could apply (Job reference nr. 2019-07)

# **Profile:**

- Qualified, enthusiastic and experienced teachers are required to teach in the secondary cycle.
- The teachers should be native speakers of English, or have a good knowledge of English (C1/C2).
- Ability to teach more than one above-mentioned subject would be an advantage.
- Good team-work with other teachers is expected.
- Good planning and ICT skills are essential.
- The number of lessons in each subject may change due to the pupil numbers in the groups.
- A full-time job is 21 periods. One period is 45 minutes.
